Objection: "We ought to obey God rather than men." (Acts 5:29)

Why should we be subject?

For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God.

(Romans 13:1)

"...The Most High rules in the kingdom of men, and gives it to whomever He chooses."

(Daniel 4:25)

Objection:

- Governments rise and fall for rational reasons.
- ➤ Did God "appoint" Adolf Hitler?



Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God,

The ordinance of God: What God has appointed or arranged.

and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves.

(Romans 13:2)

For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to evil. (Romans 13:3)

Objection:

- Many governments are corrupt!
- ➤ Many governments oppose the gospel!

For he is God's minister to you for good.

But if you do evil, be afraid; **for** he does not bear the sword in vain;

for he is God's minister, an avenger to execute wrath on him who practices evil.

God's wrath!

God's minister =

"diakonos"

= A servant, attendant,
table waiter




Therefore you must be subject,

honour to whom honour.


